GENERAL FUNCTION

All Faiths Food Bank, with the help of donors, partners and agencies, implements a Summer Feeding Program in efforts to reach children and families with food during the summer when they are not receiving meals at school and there are additional economic constraints for the family. The Summer Outreach Worker serves as a key point-of-contact of an assigned region in DeSoto County to build awareness of and to encourage participation in the summer feeding programs offered by AFFB and partners.

MAJOR DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Implements a door-to-door outreach strategy providing information on local food distributions to assigned communities throughout Desoto County.
- Raise awareness of Summer Feeding Program by providing information during parent pick-ups at designated partner sites.
- Reduces stigmas and other barriers to summer feeding services by providing information to families.
- Represents AFFB at child-centric community events, schools and health fairs in Desoto County to promote Summer Feeding Programs and increase participation.
- Attends food distributions in Desoto to provide nutrition education or other assistance as necessary.
- Delivers promotional materials and schedules for the Summer Feeding Program to partner sites.
- Utilizes designed survey tools to collection client feedback.
- Documents all activity through data collection and reporting systems.
- Other duties as assigned.

- Knowledge of and comes from the community served, Desoto County.
- *High school diploma or equivalent required.*
- Valid driver's license and reliable transportation required. Must show proof of valid auto insurance.
- Demonstrates empathy, respect, and understanding of community values and members.
