For over thirty years, All Faiths Food Bank (AFFB) has offered food and hope to the hungry in Sarasota and DeSoto Counties. Our mission is, together with our partners, we provide healthy solutions to end hunger in our community. In 2019, AFFB helped feed more than 96,000 people through our network of more than 200 agencies and programs in Sarasota and DeSoto Counties.

All Faiths Food Bank, with the help of donors, partners and agencies, is a leader in the response efforts of the COVID-19 pandemic in our community. Unemployment rates and school closures have increased food insecurity rates, demonstrated through increased SNAP, or food stamp application submissions, resulting in increased participation at existing food distribution sites. All Faiths Food Bank is responding to the growing demand by identifying expanded food distribution strategies in targeted areas where there has been a disproportional impact by COVID-19.

GENERAL FUNCTION

All Faiths Food Bank is currently seeking temporary, part-time AFFB Ambassadors to represent the organization and provide support of expansion efforts. The AFFB Ambassadors will build awareness of food distributions in the community and encourage participation to food bank services as well as support the expanded services through general operations.

MAJOR DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Conducts community outreach through placement of door hangers with information on local food distributions to assigned communities throughout Sarasota County.
- Posts/removes signage in strategic locations prior to food distributions.
- Delivers promotional materials and schedules to local organizations/partners.
- Prepares all marketing materials in advanced to scheduled community outreach.
- Attends Mobile Pantries to log existing clients and register new clients.
- Packs and distributes food at assigned Mobile Pantries.
- Provides assistance at partner food pantry sites when requested.
- Utilizes designed survey tools to collect client feedback.
- Documents all activity through data collection and reporting systems.
- Other duties as assigned.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS/SKILLS:

- At least one year experience in community work, non-profits, health care, or related field in Sarasota County.
- Demonstrates empathy, respect, and understanding of community values and members.
- *High school* diploma or equivalent *required*.
- Ability to accommodate a flexible schedule, including evenings and weekends.
- Must be able to lift at least 30 pounds.
- Ability to stand and work in heat for 3-4 hours at food distributions.
- Ability to adhere to social distancing and mask requirements.
- Bilingual a plus.
- Valid driver's license and reliable transportation required. Must show proof of valid auto insurance.
- Computer literacy and proficiency in technology and common software.
